


APRIL EVENT GATEWAY CLASSIC CARS CAFFEINE AND CHROME SHOW

DETROIT AUTORAMA LONE FORD IN THE GREAT EIGHT 2024


The Detroit Autorama is likely best-known for its prestigious custom car award named "The Ridler." It is chosen from a field of eight of what are considered to be the best-of-the-best new, never-before-seen customs that make up what is known as "The Great Eight" competition.

The first rule for qualification? The custom vehicle must be making its first ever public appearance at the Detroit Autorama. This includes not only in-person showings, but also any public posts to social media or forums with photos that show the car or any of its unique attributes.

Another rule that may surprise some skeptics is that each vehicle must be fully operable to compete. The custom vehicles "must start, stop, move forward and backward under its own power, turn left and right and stop using the brake pedal, and be driven to its display spot on the floor." Those are the minimum qualifying guidelines.
